How to join the Cymru Community Trust

You express a Private Express Trust (PET) which is then protected by Cymru Community Trust.

- Your PET can then become a beneficiary of Cymru Community Trust.
 - This is no longer a Community Trust under the Universal Community Trust (UCT) – Cymru Community Trust is a purely legal intervention Trust that pre-dates UCT, having been founded on October 13th 2011.
 - The Cymru Community Trust will run a 2-trust protection system, where your PET sits under the protection of the Cymru Community Trust.
- A Notice of Trust can be completed if you wish to have evidence that you have a PET.
- An agreement is signed to join Cymru Community Trust – this is so we know who is protected.
- £2 per month subscription is required towards running of the Cymru Community Trust, covering things like email address, paying for a postal box and forwarding services, and renting a phone line.
- If you have any legal issues, debts or fines which the trustees are able to help with, then there are further costs to be covered such as time, writing letters, buying stationary, buying ink, driving to the post office, paying for postage. This work will be done by <https://www.DebtTactics.co.uk> at a discount (unfortunately there is no sweat equity outside of the UCT, so the trustees' costs of helping on cases needs to be covered).
- Trust Certificates (£3 each) and ID badges (£5 each) can be purchased as further evidence you are part of the Cymru Community Trust.
- You are not able to be a beneficiary of Cymru Community Trust and join the UCT, as there would be a conflict of interest.
